## **Welcome to New Goshenhoppen Church**

*Thomas à Kempis writes:*

*Jesus has many who love his kingdom in heaven, but few who bear his cross. He has many who desire comfort, but few who desire suffering. He finds many to share his feast, but few his fasting. All desire to rejoice with him, but few are willing to suffer for his sake. Many follow Jesus to the breaking of bread, but few to the drinking of the cup of his passion. Many admire his miracles, but few follow him in the humiliation of the cross.*

This morning, we complete our journey through the Lord's Prayer with the closing doxology of the prayer: *for thine is the kingdom, the power, and the glory forever. Amen!* This phrase is not found in the earliest of the documents we have and appears to be added by "copyists" in later scrolls. It was the tradition of the Rabbis of Jesus's day to add such a doxological statement to the end of their prayers and it certainly would be in keeping with Jesus' way of prayer.

Next Sunday, Rev'd Erick Kern will lead Sunday worship as I am taking the first week of my annual vacation. Likely, I will be lurking for a few days around East Greenville before heading west to visit with friends.

We celebrate Rev'd Kern's installation as Associate Pastor today at the 10:30 a.m. service. Rev'd Nick Pence will arrive towards the end of the service to lead the liturgy on behalf of the Ursinus Association and Pennsylvania Southeast Conference of the United Church of Christ.

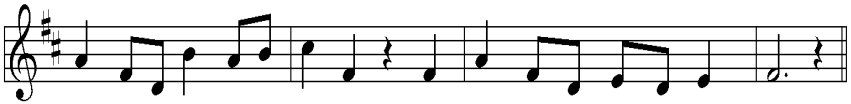
